In general anything can be a substrate and students often make great finds at thrift stores and garage sales, dragging in wooden trays, old windows and even furniture tables to work on. I start students off on day one with a supplied small ornament or tile coaster substrate to learn basic cutting techniques, giving them a practice piece and a week to think about the design work on their main projects.

Students generally choose a wide array of different projects to their taste, but in group or corporate settings I can also provide one project concept such as stepping stones and everyone will work their own design ideas within that scope.
